text:

Dear Sidney,

This is me on the typewriter, using the bad hand.  
Again I want to say I am glad to have been with you,  
after having felt close to you from our letters;  
I hope that our friendship will grow and continue

Please tell Merrit that I talked with Ed Stainbrook  
yesterday. He has just moved to a lovely house near New  
Haven and is delighted at the prospects of his new  
work. Tell Merrit I expect him and his wife to visit  
me as planned.
