Letter XIII: addressed by mother, same as previous
dated Oct. 3, 1950

text:

So pleased you are planning to visit me and see
the play. Any dates are convenient for us--just let
me know--and I hope it will be soon.

France. Wish you were along.

text:

Oct. 6. Hotel Eden, Rome.

you were along. Will be here 3 weeks then return to
our little house near Paris. Write soon.
