Trustee Mark Eaker '69 Inspires Fellow Trustees to Complete Fundraising for the New Hillel House

I have great news to share: fund raising for our new W&L Hillel House is complete! On Friday evening, May 8, the Washington and Lee Board of Trustees made final gifts to reach the goal of \$4 million, which includes an endowment for long-term maintenance.

On Thursday afternoon, May 7, we reported to the Campaign Cabinet that we were \$470,000 short of our goal. The Trustees and the University were pleased with the progress and eager to complete the fund-raising as soon as possible so that we could break ground for the Hillel House on schedule in September. What followed on Friday evening was truly remarkable.

Trustee Mark Eaker '69 of Austin, Texas, a previous supporter of the Hillel House, decided to commit half—or \$235,000—of the \$470,000 needed. Mark wanted his

gift to challenge others to give an equal amount. Fellow Trustees responded immediately. In about 60 minutes, Mark's challenge was met, and the entire \$470,000 was pledged! The Trustees were not only generous, but very enthusiastic in their support of the Hillel House.

One hundred sixty five individuals or couples have supported the Hillel House, and made our achievement possible. Several of the supporters and the gifts committed on Friday evening helped meet the \$500,000 challenge grant made last

September by Don Childress, Rector of the Board of Trustees. Of the four million dollars raised, \$844,000.00 was given by non-Jewish current and emeritus Trustees.

Construction is expected to begin in September, with completion expected in the fall of 2010. Our fund raising can now continue among alumni, parents and friends to build an endowment to support Hillel programming. We will recognize supporters who make gifts during the upcoming construction phase with available naming opportunities in the building and on the donor plaque. The plaque honors commitments of \$25,000 or more.

Thanks to all of you! I'm guessing that you are as thrilled as I am to know that our dream is now a reality. I can't wait for the party! I hope all of you will plan to be on campus for the dedication in the fall of 2010.

Birthright Israel Trip By Brian Cherry '11

This past winter break, I, along with two other Jewish students, Hugo Clifford '09 and Graham Sheridan '11, traveled to Israel on the Taglit-Birthright Israel program. The trip provides Jewish students between the ages of 18–26 a free 10-day tour of Israel. Sponsored by Jewish philanthropists and the State of Israel, the program gave us the opportunity to travel around the entire country, staying in cities such as Tel-Aviv and Jerusalem, the Negev Desert in the South, and Tiberias, where our hotel overlooked the Sea of Galilee. Along with students from other universities on the East coast, we became engrossed in Israeli culture, interacting with soldiers in the Israeli Defense Forces, eating falafel and schwarma from street vendors, and praying in a Jerusalem synagogue on Shabbat.
