

Let us swear that we shall never forget this *Communist treachery* and pray that our country will once again be united in freedom and happiness.”





“Kim Il Song was pale and emaciated when he returned to North Korea ten years ago. **Now, he has become so fat on the blood and sweat of his people he can hardly move.** On the other hand, the laboring people of North Korea have been *exploited so ruthlessly that they resemble skeletons.*”






