Indeed I have not written for so long that I hardly know how to begin. I ought to have written before this Sknow, but as Luche wrote about a week ago I thought that that would do for awhile, so dol frostfrowned wising until now, and If fear that I will fail yet for want of something to say. Perhafis an account of my tiff to this filace would not be ubolginininteresting, so Swill try and relate some of the incident that occurred on that memorable founey.

Well, we arrived at Bovingtion a feer minutes after eleven aeloch, and these we mut Major Hays, who very fondly imited us to take dinner with him, and being not ne ry hard to fersucade to go on such excursion, lave and d went, Louche and the rest of the troupe went to the merchant Hotel in Cincinnati. Wo left Cincinnati at 10 Oclock precisely for Washington, and. I think that vas about the hardest might d ever spent. We reached Wastingtion the next might alrut half after elev. next morning we got sefrasoted, Shauthan and my self X went to the depot erhere our lagsage una, the seat of the pasty went to another depot.

We found the tunes of the whole pasty, but as Luche had the checker and ale my ticket, we had to Stand on the felatfosm arsed see the cars moe off. When they (the cars) seactied the other defoe and they (the logs) saw That neither ire, nos the treks were aboard, they delivered the choke all veer to Gave who came back and found us nt the hotel, so we had a day in Washington to see the sights and we made wac of it tore. We went to the Patent office, the Capitol the White Blower $X^{C} X^{C}$. We left Ursehington Hodeses Ohwsday mervin about $\rightarrow$ Ocloek and asvired at al foshen about 6 Deloek. That evening. Ne then took the stage, over the roughest road I eves eavifor Lexington and reached here about, Delocte Friday moving.
I was very much disaffornted in the tron, as el expected to find it about four tines aces lase as it is. We moved to mIne. Datricker Friday evening, and remained those until thus evening, where such and myself moved to Col. Pohnetises, and Gave vent lack it mr.etlexandere where he was last year.

dins wy well se far. S am e studying Latin, Escek, English, huathenatie, I am in the pi. class in all excefit the \&reek, in that am in firefariting.
I havint been horne sick yet, but l would like to see you all about now.
