We are still getting the Yankees by ones Col Stuarts certainly will attack the city cavalry brought in a mere band yesterday he is the last all their forces & rendering est looking specimen of the genus home I ever had the pleasure to see He asked him care of sickness since we now many cavalry they had left Lexington William across the river he said 10,000 Rector was removed from 40,000,000 infantry endear camp today he had a slight to make us think he is crazy attack of the measles no one but cant succeed he is not else has them.

what he pretends to be his hands have fingers about my are as white & as delicate looking his health is very fine as a girls once or twice we took I have not had more feet min off his guard he talks very since I left home nor been sensible indeed sick one minute never was

It is reported to day that no well in my life not even the Yankees have struck this the headache the Captain tents and are going towards says I stand it better today

I had not expected to take another sheet but just as I was finishing the other one
broke me up a shower & I ran into my tent & as every thing was so comfortable
I concluded to try my hand on another. George White
has written to the Captain telling
him that he was coming on
to join him, & have just
heard that we will move on
comp to another piece of land
about a mile off they were here
staying too long in one place
it will get sickly. I ^{was}
^{now before} on guard last night hours &
was not the least tired when
I come off. We get up every
morning at half past four & have
gotten so used to it that I

jump up before the drum beats. We drill six times a day in the hot sun & such a black set of fellows you never saw in your life if I was to come home you would think I was some Col's waiting boy.

There are two deserters here from our army they belong to Col Hills regiment in Western Virginia but as they were caught here, we will try them & suppose.
